THE VINEYARDS

The Vineyards of Corazon Del Sol are located in the center of the Uco Valley at the base of the Andes Mountains. Each of their three vineyards are planted on different soil types, which allows us to explore the different textures and complexities imparted by each one. These soils give us low yields, but high flavor concentration. At 3,600 ft above sea level, the vines enjoy an almost extreme elevation that contributes a beautiful natural acidity to our complex, delicate wines.

THE WINEMAKER

With over 16 years in the wine industry, Cristian Moor brings a wide range of experience to his role as Head Winemaker for Corazón Del Sol. After earning a degree in Viticulture and Enology from Maza University, Cristian has worked for wineries both large and small, and continues to co-own his family garage winery MOOR BARRIO WINES with his wife. Cristian has also been hosting a successful wine radio program “Matices Del Vino” since 2012.

TASTING NOTES

100% Grenache from a single acre block that is the purest representation of Grenache in all of Argentina. A rarely found variety in Mendoza (less than 30 acres planted in 2008, when we planted our first acre). Beautiful concentration with bright red fruit and silky tannins, reminiscent of the great Grenache wines of the world.

TASTING NOTES

This pioneer wine is making history in Argentina! 'Luminoso' comes from the original 3-acre block of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre that was planted at Corazón del Sol to produce Argentina's first GSM blend from a vineyard, reminiscent of Châteauneuf-du-Pape at 3,600' in elevation.
