NORMAN M. LIPMAN AWARD



The public commemoration of the Norman M. Lipman Award is a specially commissioned sculpture, **Man of Love and Wisdom**, by Tennessee artist Terry Williams. Created of burnished steel, the twelve-foot statue depicts a figure striding forward in confident leadership. His hand is outstretched, palm up, in a gesture of support and encouragement. On his arm is the heart of love, and on his shoulder the owl of divine perception and wisdom.

A special committee was formed to take proposals from young, local artists to choose which one would best commemorate Norman Lipman's life and relationships with others and honor the recipients of the Norman Lipman Award. On permanent loan to Saint Thomas Hospital in Nashville, where Norman Lipman received treatment and comfort during his final illness, the sculpture is housed in a private atrium where the families of cancer patients can retire for peace and reflection.

Each Norman M. Lipman Award recipient receives a small steel replica of **the owl from Man of Love and Wisdom**, created annually by artist Terry Williams as a unique recognition of his or her achievement.
